

2020 West High Entertainment Unit Europe Trip Information

Where: Budapest, Vienna, Prague, Berlin

When: June 19-July 1, 2020

See attached brochure for trip itinerary, cost of trip and terms and conditions. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the city destinations will not change; however, activities and tours are subject to change.

Documentation required to participate:

- 2-page West High Entertainment Unit Europe Trip Application (Traveler information, Eligibility, Code of Conduct) for each traveler
- TUSD Waiver Letter (WHEU parent/guardian)
- First payment is due by January 25, 2019 (along with completed documentation noted above). Receipt of payment after the first due date may result in an increase in price.

Traveler Eligibility

Student traveler:

- Must be enrolled in the WHEU for the entire 2019/2020 school year and maintain the TUSD/WHS academic and citizenship standards; if a student drops mid-year or does not maintain these standards, he/she will be dropped from the trip with financial penalty.
- Must meet the annual WHEU fall/winter season contributions for 2019/2020, as well as TUSD transportation contribution, per the WHEUPA payment schedule.

Alumni (2019 or prior graduates) interested in participating in this trip must be approved by Mr. Bani prior to submitting these registration forms and deposit, must agree to the code of conduct for student travelers, and will perform with the Entertainment Unit.

All travelers must agree in writing to the code of conduct for this trip. Travelers commit to meeting the payment plan and accept KI's penalties for dropping from trip. Scholarships/financial support are not available.

Code of Conduct

Student and alumni travelers participating as members of the Entertainment Unit must adhere to all of the district policies as well as all of the school rules. Student and alumni travelers must remember that they are representing our nation as well as West High Entertainment Unit. The following are not permitted:

- Purchase and/or consumption of tobacco, alcohol (even if of legal age), vaping or drugs, except pre-approved prescription and/or over-the-counter medications.
- Possession of a firearm, knife, explosive (including firecrackers & poppers), or other dangerous object.
- Breaking any laws of the host country.
- Violating daily curfew or failing to adhere to stated boundaries.
- Inappropriate relationship behavior, sexual harassment, or visits to hotel rooms of the opposite gender.
- Failing to follow the directions of the band director, chaperone, tour guide, or bus driver.
- Failure to respect property including that of hotels, buses and facilities visited.
- Distractive behaviors (yelling, drumming, etc) that are disruptive to the driver, tour guide, or group at a group function. Stereos are not permitted.

The consequences for failure to adhere to these rules will be determined by the Band Director in conjunction with the Trip Coordinator. Decisions made on disciplinary actions are final and any costs associated with carrying such decisions are borne by the traveler.

Parent/sibling travelers please keep in mind that this trip is, first and foremost, for the student members of the Entertainment Unit. Student needs and itinerary take precedence. Parents must receive permission in advance from the band director prior to taking their student for an activity separate from the unit. Please keep these to a minimum. Parent/sibling travelers also represent our nation and the West High Entertainment Unit and should model the behavior required of the students. If adult non-designated chaperone travelers choose to drink, they should do so responsibly and discretely. Be on time for scheduled departures and tours. The group will not wait for parent/sibling travelers who fail to hold to a departure schedule. Any cost incurred as a result of missing a group departure/tour will be the responsibility of the traveler.
